

You can reach the venue:


• By train: walking distance from the railway station

• **By car:** from the motorway take the Ring Road ("Tangenziale"); Exit no. 7 "Bologna Centro"; you will arrive in *Via Stalingrado*, continue straight ahead into *Via Mascarella*; turn right into *Via Irnerio* and continue straight ahead until you come to a roundabout in *Via dei Mille*; then turn right into *Via Gramsci* taking the first street on the right which is *Via Montebello*. The Conference

Centre has private parking.

To reach the hotel using satellite navigation, it should be set for Via Milazzo 6 to avoid the restricted traffic zone.
